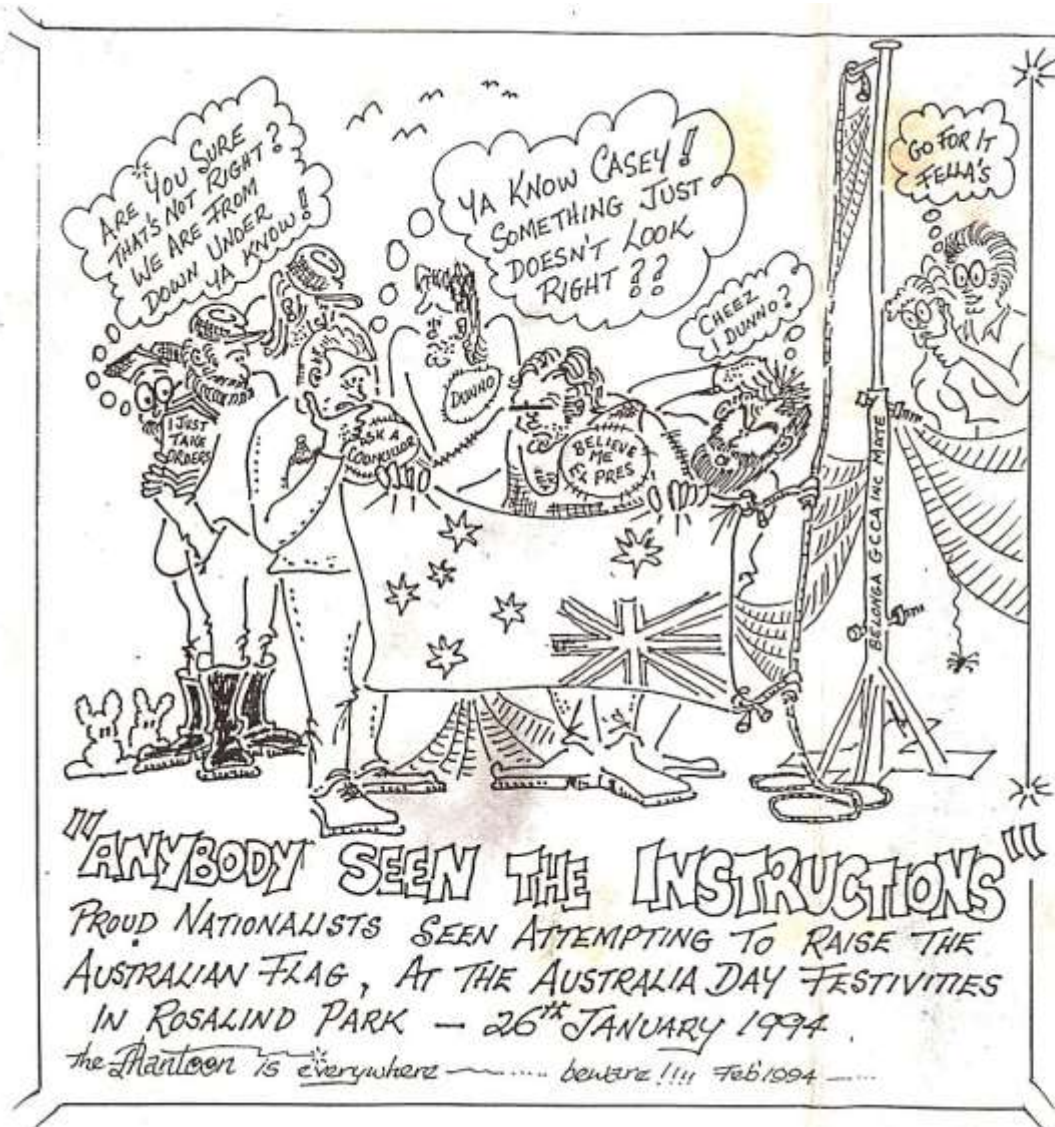


From the Archives!
